knowledge one can be knowledgeable without being wise knowledge is when you know you should hear the word and the importance of it wisdom is hearing and knowing how and when to use it word and how to live it in order for us to obey him and be in obedience god wants us to have knowledge of him and his commands as of his word our knowledge begins when we fear god if we lack or despise wisdom we are foolish and not knowledgeable wisdom is a gift from god scriptures tell us if any of you lacks wisdom let him ask god who gives generously to all without reproach and it will be given him james 1 5 esv just knowing the bible and facts about god is not all there is to wisdom god blesses us with wisdom for us to use the knowledge we have of him in order for us to glorify him the fear of the lord is the beginning of knowledge but fools despise wisdom and instruction proverbs 1 7 kjv in our spiritual maturity let us fear god and let us not be foolish but wise and knowable pleasing god this book teaches us giving one an understanding and affords us the opportunity to be blessed and favored with wisdom it expresses and confirms who we are in christ jesus i am the church of the great i am to god be the glory

calling it as i see it is a book of poetry portraying black life in general as i have seen it throughout my life each short story in rhyme is written from the heart i think some will touch you personally and others will remind you of the trail and tribulations of others i am thankful to god for the gift of rhyme

the little house on the farm was located in the southern part of north carolina it was surrounded by fields and woods this was the playground for the four little rayner blackman girls especially in the spring and summer they loved playing in the fields and woods life was innocent and care free to them sometimes the girls and their brother would get in trouble and their parents had to punish them they learned their lesson from it there was a special bond they had as a family and with their relatives

and friends how they dealt with sickness and death of their loved one the family had faith and love in jesus christ and that faith was tested when their mother and sister s lives were in jeopardy the family had many many blessings in the little house on the farm
